


INTERESTED IN SEEING IF YOUR EMPLOYER PARTICIPATES IN DONATION MATCHING?



Donation Matching Checklist:
Find out if your employer offers donation matching If your employer offers donation matching: Find out if there are minimum donation requirements or other guidelines that might have an impact on your gift Let your HR representative know that you intend to make a gift. If possible, provide the gift amount, date of the gift, and method of the gift for their reference. If your employer does not offer donation matching: Prepare to discuss the benefits of gift matching with data and statistics that demonstrate the advantages for nonprofit organizations and employers.
